Full Paper Guidelines

1. Format

- (1) Full Paper shall be on A4 in paper size and 3 pages.
- (2) Font shall be Times New Roman and 10.5 points in body parts.
- (3) Allow 16mm of left & right margin and 24mm top & bottom margin of a page.
- (4) Do not include any headers, footers or page numbers.
- (5) Do not insert corporate/ organization logos.

2. Submission

- (1) Attach your paper in PDF file and send email to kokusai@ngsk.or.jp.
- (2) File name shall be your name followed by comma and three keywords of your presentation title.

Example: "Michi Gesui, Public communication comic.pdf"

- (3) We will send a confirmation email of receipt.

1. Poster Size

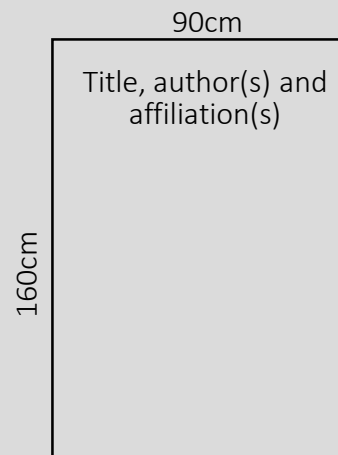
160cm in vertical x 90cm in horizontal
